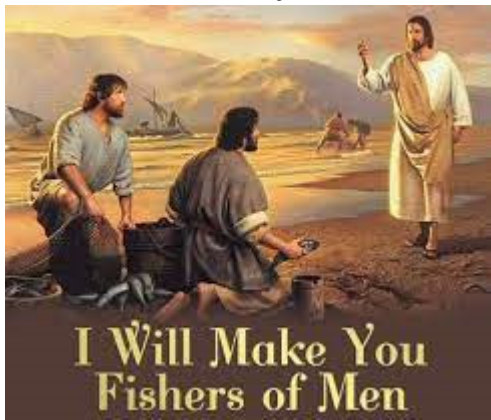

As announced at each of the Masses last weekend, Bishop Paprocki has decreed the appointment of Fr. Pawel "Paul" Luczak to a parochial vicar at our parishes, effective July 1, 2022. Fr. "Paul" is from the country of Poland and was ordained for our diocese by Bishop Paprocki two years ago in the priestly class of 8. That group of priests included fellow Polish native, Fr. Piotr Kosk who served as Deacon in our parishes prior to his priestly ordination. Fr. Piotr Kosk has been appointed pastor of St. Mary's, Taylorville, Holy Cross, Stonington and St. Rita's, Kincaid.

How can I then do the mercy work of giving drink to the thirsty and food to the hungry?

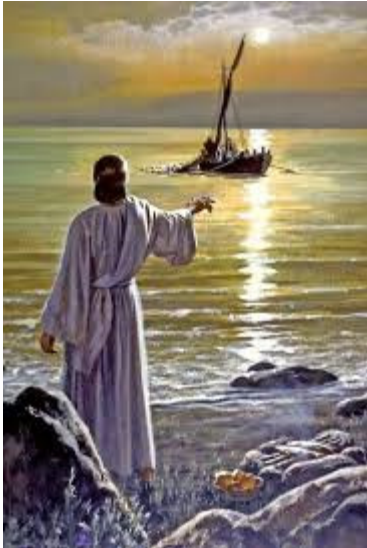
