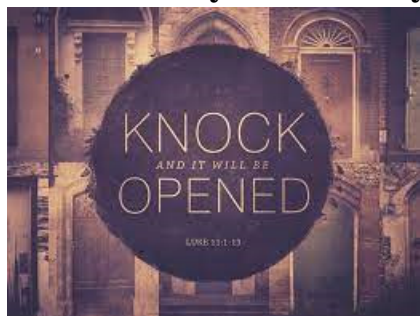

The Family of Jarrett Zumbahlen would like to pass along that we have appreciated everyone's thoughts and prayers. We would also like to thank everyone involved in the beautiful funeral Mass and music, and extend a thank you to all the ladies of the parish for the delicious desserts. Your kindness and thoughtfulness during this time has meant so very much to our family.

Did you know Sister Stanislaus (Christina) Saul, the foundress of our parish school of St. Thomas the Apostle Parish in Newton in 1884, is buried in our Mount Cavalry Cemetery. Mother Stanislaus Saul died at the St. Thomas Convent of typhoid fever, a bacterial infection spread by contaminated food or water.

As her tombstone is hard to decipher and as a memorial to the foundress of our wonderful parish school, the Pastoral Council recommended **creating a memorial plaque acknowledging her contribution to our parish school.** If you are interested in making a donation for this fund, simply write Mother Stanislaus Memorial Fund on the envelope you use for your donation.

At the age of 16, Christina Elisabetha Saul entered the Congregation of Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet near St. Louis, Missouri on February 2, 1850. She adopted the religious name of Sister Mary Stanislaus and professed vows on August 24, 1852. At the age of 23, she was appointed Mother Superior and from then on led pioneering "advance teams" of sisters to found 10 schools and orphanages which she administered in four states.

Scheduling a Baptism at St. Thomas or St. Mary's:

After all required baptismal papers have been turned into the particular parish, **call the parish office to schedule the baptism.** A baptism will be scheduled only when all necessary paperwork is filed.

A Godparent-Sponsor must be a participating Catholic. If two Godparents, one must be male and the other be female. A non-Catholic cannot be a sponsor but can serve as a Christian witness but everyone present is a witness. Baptisms are scheduled during Mass so that the child/person can be welcomed into the Church, the family of God.
