It is the day after Labor Day and we can give thanks for those who labored to get the new Church built and those who have labored to pay off the debt while laboring in prayer each week in thanksgiving, petitioning and adoring our Lord Jesus Christ at Mass. The Event is planned for the Rosary Group at 5:00 p.m., followed by the 5:30 p.m. Mass of Thanksgiving with a symbolic mortgage burning and refreshments in the Parish Center. Mark your calendars. ## FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS:

While diligently working to pay off the church debt, improvements have been made to our parish facilities, in the Parish Center (renovating and updating the restrooms, and water-fountains, microphone system and replacing an air-conditioner unit. The Parking lot has been repaired and restriped. The Playground has been updated with concrete work to replace old railroad ties, and the equipment given new coat of paint.
