**What to expect when
we return to Mass**

Before you arrive

- Check your temperature and if you have one, please do not come to church
- Stay home if you are feeling symptomatic
- Do not bring anything to church you are not able to sanitize properly
- When adults maintain social distancing, a mask is not required.
- Allow plenty of time to arrive 5-10 minutes early to assist with the flow of seating

When you arrive

- Enter only in marked doorways
- Be patient with ushers and greeter who will help you and your family find safe seating
- Sanitize your hands before entering
- Always observe social distancing of six feet. Your family may remain together.
- Please refrain from close discussion or gatherings of any kind in the vestibule or pews.

During the Mass

- Do not change seats during the service
- There will be no passing of the offering baskets. We appreciate your gift!
- If you are interested in contributing online, safe and secure online giving is available. Please contact the parish offices for more information.
- No physical sign of peace will be exchanged during the Mass
- Follow instructions for communion. Ushers will be able to assist you.
- You may remain in the pew if you feel more comfortable and make a Spiritual Communion.
- Please maintain social distancing guidelines throughout Mass, if you have to leave the worship space, please re-sanitize your hands upon your return
- Restrooms will be available, please sanitize before returning to your pew
